

Confirming Correct eTrex H Configuration & Geocoding Nests

Confirming WAAS Operation

- Look at the Advanced Skyview Screen, you will see Satellite #51 on the right side of the list – That is the WAAS Satellite! Any satellite number greater than 32 is a WAAS Satellite
- Wait until you see “D”’s on top of several Satellite Bars. “D” means that the WAAS Satellite is correcting readings from the other satellites and increasing accuracy. In the heading you will see “DIFF:” to confirm the more accurate readings



Geocoding Nests

- Hold the GPS Receiver directly over Clutch location
- On Advanced Skyview screen, make sure to wait until accuracy is 15 Feet or Less
- Wait for “DIFF” Indicator to Confirm WAAS Corrections
- Hold down ENTER to lock Location
- Be sure that Latitude and Longitude have 5 Decimal Places and CAREFULLY transcribe into Zone Book
